I am not much help but I will tell you what I can. I did not fly any missions with Thomas. We were assigned to 306 late April '43 right after a heavy loss (Bremen, I think) and our crew was broken up for replacements. I do not have any record of flying in "Maryland" but that plane was Reeher's (Col. Kenneth Reeher 38 DaVinci, Lake Oswego, Or. 97034, I note that he was at one of the reunions (Omaha?) So you may have a more recent address for him. I did not fly missions with Rice either. My memory on that is that he had high altitude problems and after a few missions was re-assigned to B-25's but I do not have any dates. I can't locate my list of original crew with addresses and do not recall where Rice was from. I completed my Missions on 3 Nov 43 (Wilhelmshaven) and assigned 4-Nov 43 to CCRC Northern Ireland until back to States in April of '44. After Instructors School at Monroe La I was assigned to Cadets and returned combat navigators at Ellington Field until I went on terminal leave on 4 Sept 45.
