Dear Mr. Strong;



I am Calven P. Conrey, the person you are seeking. I was a navigator with the 369th. Squadron for 8 months from November of 1943 to July of 1944. I served as staff navigator of the 369th. from December 1943 until I rotated to the States. Our crew commander was Leroy Peterson and our aircraft was "Satan's Lady", one of the few planes to last through in access of 100 sorties.

I was once informed of a 306th. reunion in Chicago by George Belknap, but as I was in Japan at the time, I was unable to attend.
