Dear Mr. DiThomas:

Your letter has come along to me concerning Andrew Bezak. My records indicate that he joined the 306th Bomb Group 3 April 1942 at Wendover, UT, and went to England with the group in September.

He was a member of the 423rd Bomb Squadron and was engineer on the crew of Lt. Maurice Salada.

He was the third enlisted man in the Group to complete a tour of 25 missions, in May 1943. In the course of this tour of duty he earned an Air Medal and three oak leaf clusters, and the Distinguished Flying Cross.

Bezak left the 306th at the completion of his tour, probably returned to the U. S. for a 30-day leave, and most likely sought and received assignment to another bomb group, either one then in England ar one that was still in training in the States and with which he went to England.

I am positive that he did not return to the 306th, as I have found no record of his being with the group during the 1944 period. He very likely met his death with another Group. Merseberg was a hot target.

To find any further information, I would suggest that you write the Military Records Section, Attn: Missing in Action, National Archives, Weashington, DC 20409. Request that they send you a copy of the Missing in Action record showing his name. That will tell you what group and crew he was flying with, etc. If you do receive such a record, I would very much appreciate receiving a copy of it. T/Sgt. Andrew Bezak's serial # was 15069851. He had no middle name.
