Thank you for sending the 1986 Directory of the 306th Bomb Group Historical Association. Four members of my B-17 crew were listed. At this moment I don't know the whereabouts of any other 306th veterans.

I was a radio operator on a B-17 crew with the 367th Squadron of the 306th Group. My pilot was Dinwiddie Fuhrmeister, my navigator was Arthur F. Titus, my ball turret gunner was Owen K. Nabors, and my engineer was O.F. Harvey, Jr. Dinwiddie Fuhrmeister became the commander of our squadron and on October 14th, 1943 our crew was split up to fly the Schweinfurt mission. I was shot down on the mission and ended up a P.O.W. in Stalag XVIIIB near Krems, Austria.

I am enclosing a check for \$10.00. Thank you again for providing names and addresses of the 367th squadron. I plan to get in touch with my crew.
