Bringing space age technology to bear on the problems of disabled veterans is the mission of a new Rehabilitative Engineering Research and Development Center at the Veterans Administration hospital, Palo Alto, Calif.

The center is the second of its type to be established by VA Administrator Max Cleland. In July 1977, Cleland announced the first such center at the Hines VA Hospital in Chicago.

The Palo Alto center will work closely with the Stanford University School of Medicine and Stanford School of Engineering.

Staffing at the center will build slowly from its present level of only four to 30 full-time employees by Fiscal Year 1981. These are in addition to six pre-doctoral engineering Fellows from Stanford who are already collaborating with VA personnel and patients in the development of biomedical engineering projects.

Here is another list. I've reviewed the missing air crew reports, and as I would like to hear from someone out of each of the planes in which their were survivors, the list is fairly long.

I don't expect immediate responses from you, but just will supply stuff that you can feed into the system as time and energy are available.

I have actually begun to write now, so am trying to pick up a lot of loose ends.

You might be interested that several of these names are lone survivors, and four of them are survivors of a big three-plane crash May 7, 1944, en route to Berlin. When I was at Thurleigh no one thought anyone had survived, but my records show that several gunners made it. None of the officers did, however.

I have culled the list so that I have not duplicated names I've sent you before, nor have I sent you any people I KNOW to be deceased.

Out of that short list I sent you last week, I just learned that Robert Dresp, whom I believe was the first name on the list, actually died of wounds sometime in mid-1943.

It was good to see you in Washington yesterday, and I am pleased to know that you are helping with the 1987 reunion. I think it will be an excellent event, and I was satisfied with what the committee is doing in its planning.

I mentioned to you that I needed some help--or at least another try at some information.

In particular, I am interested in getting any information that I can on a Duane Bollenbach. His serial #was 0-729596.

He was critically dounded 24 July 43 on a raid to Norway when he was hit in the head with a 20 mm cannon shell. It tore away a lot of his skull and on the way home the ~~ham~~ held his head to try to get him home alive.

He was immediately hospitalized, of course, and was shipped back to the States as quickly as possible. I understand that he survived for a number of years, although one side was paralyzed.

I have traced him to Gamaliel, AR, and then I think he went to the West Coast.

I also learned someplace that he had retired 23 August 45 as a first lieutenant.

Can you come up with anything, as to where or when he died, or where he may have been at any time?

I'd like to put together some things for Echoes in the future.

Does the fact of retirement mean that he came off the VA roster? He must have had a pension and complete disability, or I am I not reading it correctly?

Haven't had occasion to contact you of late, but thought you might be interested in today's mail.

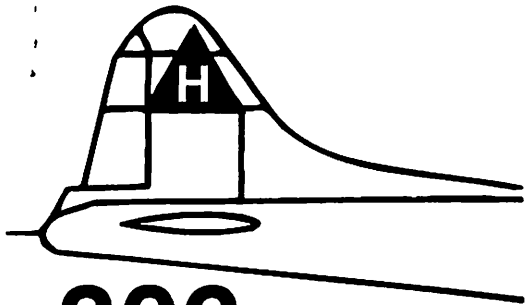
I've copied it all, including one photograph, which pictures two items recovered from the crash site of your plane, and is probably all that remains today of it.

I THINK THE PLANS OF THE FOLKS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC TO HONOR OUR AIR CREW ARE MOST GENEROUS AND COMMENDABLE. OF COURSE I'LL BE AS HELPFUL AS I CAN.

MOST OF MY WWII MEMORABILIA IS STASHED AWAY, SOMEWHERE IN THE PLETHORA OF BOXES NOW IN DISARRAY AWAITING THEIR NEW HOME, BUT I DO KNOW A LITTLE THAT MIGHT HELP.

I AM GRATEFUL FOR HIS INTEREST AND FEEL HONORED BY IT BUT I WAS NEVER ABLE TO MAKE HIM UNDERSTAND THAT I COULDN'T ANSWER SOME OF THE QUESTIONS HE ASKED.
