**Frederick L. McIntyre Sr.**

MARION - Mr. Frederick Lindsey McIntyre Sr., 75, husband of Dorothy Stewart McIntyre, died May 3, 1996, in the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston after an illness.

Graveside services were held May 4 in Rose Hill Cemetery, directed by Smith-Collins Funeral Home.

Mr. McIntyre was born March 21, 1921, in Marion County, a son of the late Blakely H. and Eulene Miller McIntyre Sr. He retired in February of 1996 as the executive director of the Housing Authority of Marion, after 30 years of service. Mr. McIntyre served during World War II with the U.S. Army 8th Air Force as a B17 pilot, where he flew 25 missions over Germany. He was the past executive director of the Mullins Housing Authority and the past president of the Carolinas Council of Housing. Mr. McIntyre graduated from the University of South Carolina in 1949, where he was a member of the Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity. He was the past president of the Marion County Gamecock Club and a former member of the Executive Committee of the Gamecock Club. Mr. McIntyre was a founding member of the University of South Carolina University Club. He was a Little League coach, a Marion High School tennis coach, and a former Boy Scout leader of Marion Troop No. 745, where he was a recipient of the Silver Beaver Award. He was a member and past president of the Marion Rotary Club and was a founding member of the Cypress Creek River Club. Mr. McIntyre was a member of the Marion Presbyterian Church, where he was a former elder and deacon of the church.

Surviving are his wife of the home; two sons, Frederick L. (Rick) McIntyre Jr. of Asheville, N.C., and Wallace Stewart McIntyre of Hartsville; two daughters, Debra (Debbie) McIntyre Wilkinson of Mullins and Sally McIntyre Rowe of Chesapeake, Va.; two brothers, Phillip M. McIntyre and Blakely H. McIntyre Jr., both of Marion; a sister, Jannes McIntyre Wallace of Marion; and six grandchildren.
