My name is Russell Robinson  
I was a former member of the  
306 Bomb Sq 369 Squadron  
(Fighter-Bomber) Our crew was  
shot down July 30 or 31 (1943)  
over Kiel Germany I was held  
P.O.W. for 22 months and  
Released It was my 4th  
mission we lost two planes,  
that day I think every one  
survived except Leornardini  
who died in a hospital  
of a Broken Hip. infection  
also Navigator ADLER never  
found, I wrote his family year  
ago, This is the first issue  
of U.F.W. I have seen an item  
concerning 306th, What's been  
going on all these years, is  
there any history or info

~~subject~~ which would be of  
interest to me. I would  
like to hear from you in  
the near future. This is the  
first letter I've written in years.
