INFORMATION:

- Effective 24 Dec/44 head lamps on motor vehicles in the UK may be used unobscured subject to compliance with normal peace time regulations made by the ministry of transport. Namely that beam is permanently deflected or can be dipped and lights are extinguished when parked except for traffic reasons. All restrictions on side lights and rear lights of motor vehicles are likewise lifted.
- Orders for Easter Gifts, through the PX, must be placed on or before 25 Jan/45.
