5. SCHEDULE FOR SENDING HOME MONEY: Effective immediately all personnel (below Field Grade Officers) on this Base will be required to go through their respective Orderly Room in sending funds home by Postal Money Order, P.M. and/or in buying war bonds thru the Station Finance Office.

SUGGESTION BOX:

SUGGESTION: "I have been told by my section head that if I take a two or three day pass a month, I am not entitled to go on one of the trips to the Continent, Glasgow, etc. Would like to know if one takes a three day pass if he becomes ineligible for one of these trips?"

SUGGESTION: "I am one of the many AFM's who have been declared essential, June 30 1945 made 34 months that I have been overseas. Now what I would like to know is all the extra-curricular activities such as trips to the Continent, Bournemouth and Glasgow only for those who have no particular duty to perform at the present time. Have the Officers over your particular section the right to refuse you permission to go, (or rather make you feel, that if you do go they will make it tough for you)? Instead of encouraging the men under their section to make these trips, several of the Officers have completely discouraged the idea, and whenever the subject is brought up it is immediately dropped aside, the answer being that we are much too busy at the present time. Suggest that a survey be made on this field of key clerical positions, and that men can be given 2 days to participate in a few of the sports that they wish to, and have not been able to participate in while the war over here was still going on. The point I am trying to stress is that every opportunity is not being given every man who would like to participate in some of the activities that are offered."

TRIP: Everyone is eligible to take leave flights to Edinburgh, Bournemouth and Schwionfurt. Requirements are to make application to your Unit Special Service Officer located in your Unit Orderly Room. It is necessary to use your regular monthly AFM leave pass to take Bournemouth or Edinburgh flight. The trip to Schwionfurt is one day trip and is not charged against your time.
