INFORMATION:

1. The following sections AFM Circular 100, dated 18 July 1945 are quoted for information and guidance of all members this station:
 III. SHOULDER SLEEVE INSIGNIA: 1. An individual formerly assigned to a unit in the theater authorized a distinctive shoulder sleeve insignia may continue wearing such insignia upon reassignment to a unit not authorized such a distinctive insignia.
 2. a. If the unit to which the individual is reassigned is authorized a distinctive shoulder sleeve insignia, then he will wear such new insignia on his upper left shoulder sleeve, as prescribed by Par 56c, AR 600-40, 31 Mar 1944, and may, in addition, wear the insignia of his former unit, in the same relative position, on the right shoulder sleeve.
 b. Each individual may select the particular unit shoulder sleeve insignia he desires so to wear on the right shoulder sleeve, providing the unit so selected is one to which he was assigned while it was stationed in an overseas theater after 7 Dec 1941.
 c. The wearing of such insignia on the right shoulder sleeve is not mandatory. Under no circumstances will more than one such insignia be worn on the right shoulder sleeve at a time. (AG 421.4 RdG)
 VII. ADDRESS OF NEW AND OLD MEMBERS: Effective as of 15 Jul 1945, the inclusion of grade or rank (private to colonel, inclusive) and unit or organization is authorized in the address of EFM's and SCIF's originating in the U.S. All personnel will advise their correspondents of their new form of address.
