

SUGGESTION BOX

SUGGESTION: "Last night after a wait of approximately forty-five minutes in front of the Officer's Red Cross Club in Bedford, the twelve o'clock liberty run truck arrived. There were about a half dozen GIs already on it, several of whom were drunk and using abusive language to some of the Officers aboard. This is the second Tuesday night running that this truck has been late. Suggest the Motor Magistrate instruct his drivers to be at the appointed place at the appointed time and see that the vehicle is used for the assigned purpose!!"

ANSWER: You failed to perform your duty as an Officer when you let drunk GIs use abusive language to Officers. Also when you failed to take the driver's name and report him properly for not being on time. The Inspection Officer can not ride every truck and can't take remedial action in cases of this kind unless Officers who have knowledge of the case report it to him.

Station regulations prohibit enlisted men from riding Officer's liberty runs; they also prohibit Officers from riding the enlisted men's liberty runs.

SUGGESTION: "Suggest some information be given to all personnel of this group as to the approximate date on which we will leave this station. There is no worse morale breaker, that a complete lack of knowledge about something that so directly and personally affects every one of us. This is particularly true in the case of this unit, where the majority of the personnel have put in a long period of overseas duty. How about letting some of us in on that gives???"

ANSWER: SB has attempted to keep you informed as far as possible about when we are to leave. The only answer available right now is that the Station Executive claims we will still be here Labor Day. (R. J. He's been saying that for 6 months).
