ITEM #1:

ITEM #3: You are referred to See I, pp 71 (3), F.M. 21-9 for information on this subject. You are not required to salute when, "carrying arms with both hands, or when otherwise so occupied as to make saluting impracticable". Station policy does not require a person riding a bicycle to either render a salute or to return one. If you are a good enough cyclist you can render a salute - otherwise, just give a verbal greeting. Some people can ride without any hands on the bike - Can You?
