SUCCESTION: "Thy is it that we are not allowed a choice of the eigers that ar available at the EX, but, instead must take whatever is placed on the shelver for the past week there have been only two brands on sale, neither of them a popular make. Not, in the storeroum in plain view are a number of boxes of on of the best American brands. When asked about them, the clerks state that they're not on sale get. Yet the pile of boxes has diminished by at least six in the past two or three days. Either somebody's friends' or the 'brass' are getting the best, while we have to take what is left. If there are sever brands available we should all be given a chence to purchase one of our own choice instead of having to take whatever the PX wishes to throw at us.

I don't know if the P. Officer has any choice in the brands he procure but if he does, I believe that the American brands are much more popular and appreciated than the Suban cigars that we're getting lately, even the

the Cuban cigars are more expensive.

Another thing I have noticed. The cherks think that they are doing us a fever. Whenever I buy something I want it to be given to me gently and not as if I was just trush and have it thrown at me. I swear that the next time one of 'hose goods at the PX thrown my eigerettes or early I will pull him out from behind the counter. They are getting paid half of their base pay and actually working for us all and getting a favor of us and not we from them. THENTHE YOU. I'M SURE SCHEMING WILL BE DONE TO COMPRET THE SITUATION.

ANNUAL: All the eigers available at the PX are placed on sale over the counter; however all eigers, regardless of type or make, must be sold in order to requisition additional supplies, so the more unpopular brands have to be sold as well as the popular once. The macrican eigers, as hall as the imported once, are sold over the counter, and neither somebody's friends not the "brass" get them, as you suggest, unless they buy them along with everyone class. If all the popular brand merchandise were placed on sale at the same time, a "run" would develop on the PX and soon nothing would remain except the more uncopular brands, and those men whose duties prohibit them from visiting the PX at their convenience would invariably have much less choice than everyone has under the present system of retioning the popular brands each day or week.

AUSTER (cont'):

So for as any choice on the part of the PZ officer is concerned when requisitioning supplies, very little is permitted, since eigers are not requisitioned by trade name; all eigers are classified by price, i.e., class i, class 2, class 6, etc., and no choice is permitted as for as make is concerned. The depot distributes all eigers on a pro rated basis among the different exemples served.

You are laboring under a interesception, if you think the employees of the PX receive any additional pay, as they definitely do not receive any pay, other than their regular army pay. SB agrees that the clorks should be polite and courteour, and they have been cautioned about their actions; however you are not doing them any favor, as you suggest. If any of the clerks do not treat you properly, the FX Officer requests that you report the incident to him at once, and appropriate action will be taken.
