SUGGESTION: "I think the War Department is doing a great job redeploying men back to the States and hope this will continue. I understand each time we lose a man we are to get a replacement and I know this was requested in many cases. I am in a Service Squadron and have been in the same rank for almost three years and can't see a possibility of getting any more as long as I stay in said Group. To explain what I really mean is simply this: A few weeks ago the Service Group has forty some men with 85 points or more and several of them have critical spec numbers. At the rate they are being relieved from the Service Squadrons it will be years before there will be a T/O rating open for any men. What few men are leaving are men who were over the T/O when the Service Group was activated and men who were transferred from the Bomb Gp after the Battle Stars were awarded which still doesn't leave an opening. It will take months and most probably years before we men who are still busy as ever will have an opportunity for promotion. The T/O ratings in the Service Squadrons are so low, especially in the 240th and 664th only a few will ever get another stripe and still we are doing or some of us are doing the same work as M/Sgts in the Bomb Gp. Why give all the ratings to the Bomb Sq men and leave us flat? Don't we deserve a break before we become 40 years of age at which time we might be eligible for discharge. This can be improved by interviewing the men who deserve a break and ask them if they would like to transfer to the Bomb Gp and make a rating and then the new men come in stick them in one of the non-service-str units. If positive transfers on the station are not frozen,

I've also seen many cases where new men come in and have been taking over the best jobs simply because they are highly ranked and sweet talk some of the Officers. I just can't see through some of this and many other fellows feel the same way. My morale is so low, I haven't the heart to work anymore as I once did.

I agree this might not seem logical to the Bomb Sq men, but nevertheless if they have been here anyplace they have 85 points or more and chances are they will be leaving for the States soon.

HOW ABOUT A LITTLE CONSIDERATION, LOOK AROUND AND SEE WHAT RANK SOME OF US ARE AND TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION WHAT THE STAFF IS IN SEPTEMBER 1942 AND ARE NOW BSA PERSONNEL. THIS IS DISCOURAGING AS HELL.

ANSWER: Recent change in command channels makes it necessary that applications for transfer between Service Group and Bomb Group and vice versa be forwarded thru channels to Hq 423 Air Force for approval.

SB has been informed that applications of deserving applicants will be favorably considered by this headquarters.

Meanwhile the anticipated release of high point Service Group personnel may make more opportunity for promotions -- at least SB hopes so.
