SUBJECT: Intelligence Narrative
Mission: KASSEL, 19th April, 1944

TO : Commanding Officer, 306th Bombardment Group (H)

1. Narrative

306th flew lead Group and lead and high squadrons of high composite group in 40th "A" CBW. Assembly of CBW was perfect and it left Cromer on time. Soon after Cromer, however, CBW identified as Division Leader dragged across 40th "A" CBW. Course as briefed until leg south to I.P. when 40th "A" CBW was forced to swing wide and below I.P. by two CBW's flying on right. Hence lead and low groups bombed on 320 degrees while high composite group, thrown out of 40th "A" CBW formation by converging CBW's, swung still farther south and bombed on 20 degree heading. After target, lead and low groups flew home about as briefed, except for group being somewhat south of course until after crossing Rhine. High composite group somewhat scattered when it met another CBW coming off target almost head on, reformed, turned right off target and flew home separately, followed by "J in triangle" Group with fighter escort and some third division A/C. Takeoff 0630, Cromer 0822 (2 minutes early), enemy coast 5236N-0435E at 0859 (5 minutes early), enemy coast again 5109N-0245E at 1211. Landed 1335 (Lead A/C at Chelveston).

2. Fighter Opposition and Fighter Support

No enemy fighters seen. Friendly support excellent except for gap after target when P-38s were eight to ten minutes late. P-51s were above formation on bombing run. We make no claims.

3. A.A. Gun Fire

Moderate but extremely accurate tracking A.A. gun fire encountered in target area. Large bursts until turn off at the target and normal sized bursts on outer fringe of gun fire area. Obviously aimed at lead group. 19 of 26 ships of 306th hit by A.A. gun fire in target area. Nine severe. 17 of 18 A/C of lead group hit at target, all of the severe damage being in lead group.

4. Bombing

Pictures show 306th lead group's 500 pound bombs in tight compact pattern squarely on M.P.I. Damage to entire plant should be severe. High group's incendiaries appear to be on end of marshalling yard extending to residential area to north and possibly to Spinnfaser plant on south. Our photos also show the 94th CBW target "B" on airfield to south to be solidly hit.

5. Weather

Scattered light clouds about 5,000 feet over continent; clear from I.P. and over target, with slight haze not affecting bombing.

6. Observations

Activity, construction, tanks, parked vehicles observed in area three miles square at 5057N-0257E.

Smoke screens reported at Bohn, Kassel, Wiesbaden, Bielefeld, Osnabruck. Large concentrations of freight cars at Charleroi Gosselies marshalling yards.

Limbar marshalling yards observed hit by bombs.

Balloon barrages at Haarlem and Amsterdam.

Approximately 20 A/C parked on Kassel airdrome.

"Mirrors" at Brussels greatly increased in number.

7. Aircraft in Distress

B-17 at target, from group behind, went down, no chutes seen.

B-17, 305th Group, peeled off near Ostend, lost to view.

One fighter down at target in flames; cause unknown.

8. Airborne Aircraft Returning Early

A/C 323-M, pilot Roeder, a spare, turned back at 0844 hours at 5246N-0308E. Brought back 10x500.

A/C 943-L, pilot Curtis, a spare, turned back at 0848 hours at 5246N-0300E. Brought back 42x447A1's.

A/C 431-F, pilot Baldwin, turned back over splasher 10 at 0727 hours. Number 4 engine out. A second engine went out on landing at Kimbolton. Brought back 10x500.

A/C 155-J, pilot McDaniel, turned back at 5221N-0007E at 0809 hours, low manifold pressure. Brought back 42x447A1's.

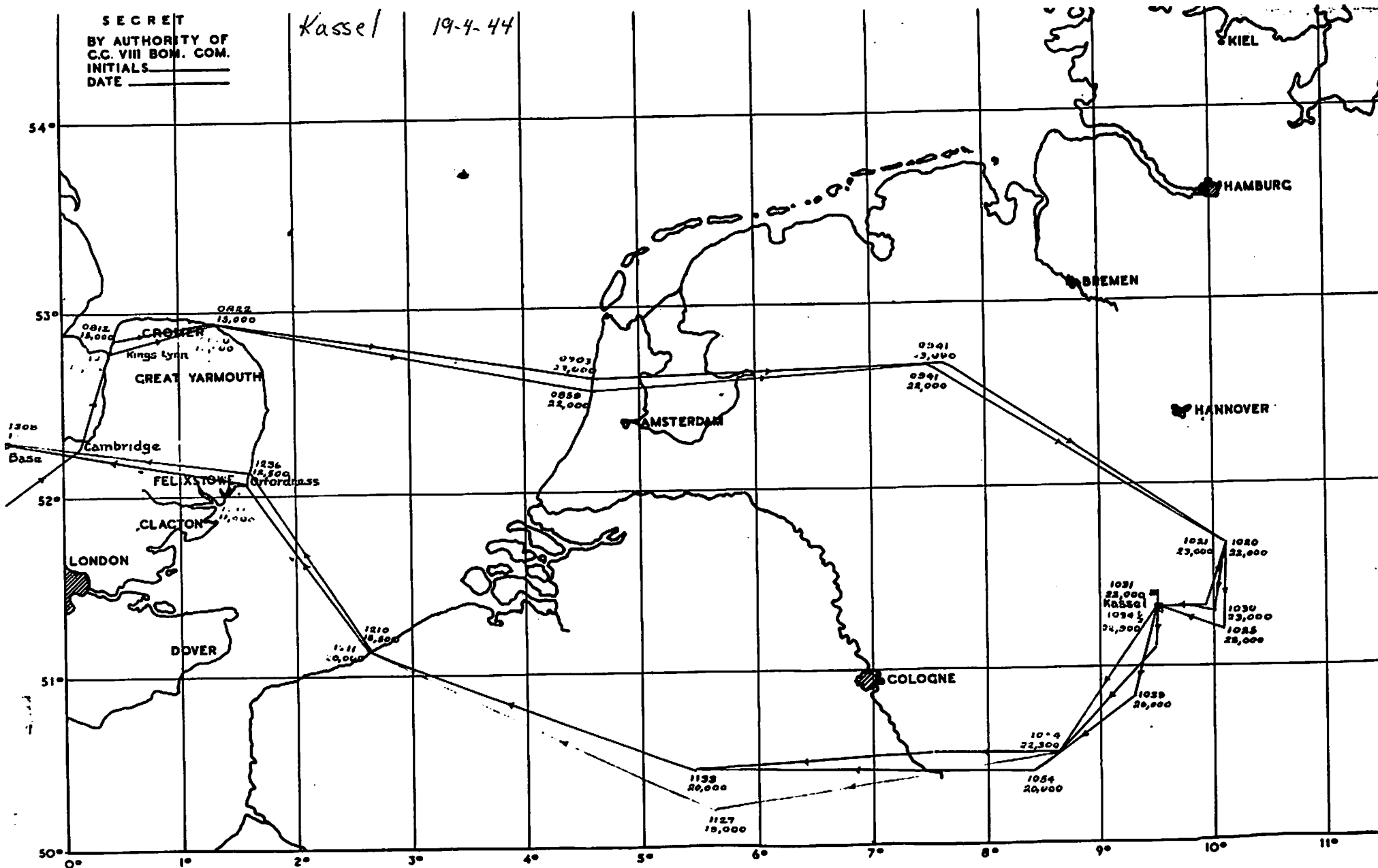
9. Dispatched Aircraft Returning Early
