SUBJECT: Intelligence Narrative
Mission: Stralsund and Stargard

TO : Commanding Officer, 306th Bombardment Group (H)

1. Narrative

306th flew 33 a/c plus 3 PFF as 40th "B" group; and 10 a/c plus 2 PFF as lead squadron 40th "D" group.

40th "B" route: English coast, 5323N-0015E, 0908 hours; enemy coast, 5434N-0900E, 1125 hours; call from Buckeye Red at 1230 hours reported 7 to 9/10 at primary. Group turned 180 degrees to left at 5331N-1340E, 1233 hours; took IP at 5407N-1337E, 1255 hours; bombed Stralsund visually at 1301½ hours; turned north to regain briefed course; enemy coast 5434N-0900E, 1352 hours; English coast, 5327N-0010E, 1533 hours; base 1614 hours.

40th "D" route: as briefed until about 5325N-1422E approximately 6 miles from target at 1243. Clouds prevented picking up assigned MPI visually as required. Group turned SE and from 5317N-1445E as IP, bombed Stargard visually 1251½; 5403N-1449E, 1308; briefed route home, base, 1656 hours.

PFF: Three PFF a/c were flown in 40th "B" group and two PFF a/c in lead squadron of 40th "D" group. All mickey equipment worked satisfactorily with exception of deputy lead of 40th "D" which reported interference from "spiraling" on scope.

2. Fighter Opposition and Fighter Support

No fighter opposition encountered.

P-51s, picked up at the Danish coast at 1120, gave close support until target area when they were apparently called away by bandits. No support on way out.

3. A.A. Gun Fire

40th "B" group found no A.A. gun fire at Stralsund or enroute, but observed meager tracking from vicinity of Eckenforde. No damage.

40th "D" lead squadron encountered moderate but low tracking A.A. gun fire at Stetin; none at target; meager accurate tracking from Waabs. Damage, 1 slight, 1 severe.

4. Bombing

On approach to IP, 40th "B" lead squadron commander received call from Buckeye Red saying that primary target was obscured by 7 to 9/10 coverage. Made 180 degree turn and attacked Stralsund, PFF last resort, starting PFF run and making visual correction 15 seconds before bombs away. Lead squadron dropped at 1301½, high and low at 1302. Strike photos show lead bombs on 052038/2 and high squadron bombs on 057043/2, briefed MPI. Strikes of low squadron carrying incendiaries do not show on photos, but evidence is strong that bombs fell on briefed aiming point.

40th "D" lead squadron started run on primary northwest of Stettin, got on course with PFF, and held heading almost until time for bombs away. Then, unable to pick up briefed MPI visually as required, turned right to bomb Stargard. Lead and high squadrons bombed Stargard visually at 1251½ hours. Bombing is excellent, strike photos showing bombs solidly on northeast dispersal area.

5. Leaflets
A/c 896-X, pilot Birdwell, dropped ten T171 on Stralsund.
6. Weather
7 to 9/10 reported at 1230 by Buckeye Red over Stargard but only 4/10, tops 10,000 found when actually bombed at 1251. 2/10 at Stralsund. North Sea area and Danish peninsula 3 to 4/10. Visibility was excellent.
7. Aircraft Returning Early
A/c 087-F, pilot Denny, did not leave traffic pattern because of engine failure immediately after take off. Brought back 10 x 500.
8. Observations
Camouflaged A/D with work in progress at 5432N-0915E. 15 sea planes observed at base, 5403N-1550E. Group of barracks type buildings on Island at 5431N-1107E. Large plane in water at 5440N-1018E. Boats approaching. Might have been ditching. No dinghies observed. Large concentration of shipping at Kiel. Also boats laying smoke screen.

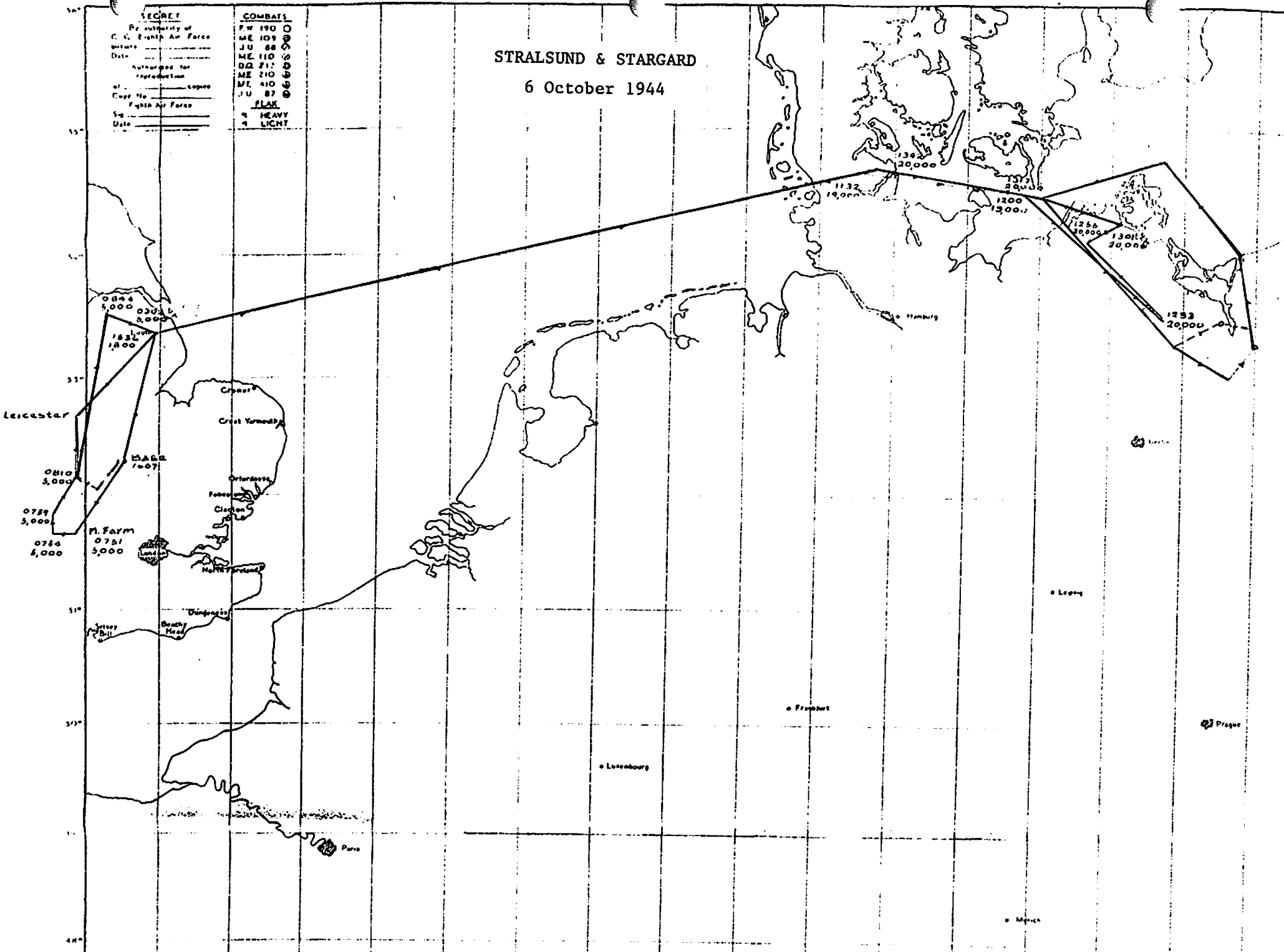
