CIRCUMSTANCES:

The aircraft took part in a bombing mission to the submarine pens at Wilhelmshaven, Germany on 15 May 1943, at which time 3 aircraft were lost from the 306th Bomb Group. Flak was intense and the cause of the loss is unknown. No search was made.
