Courses at Oxford, Cambridge and St. Andrews are available to personnel on leave or furlough. Subject are general in nature.

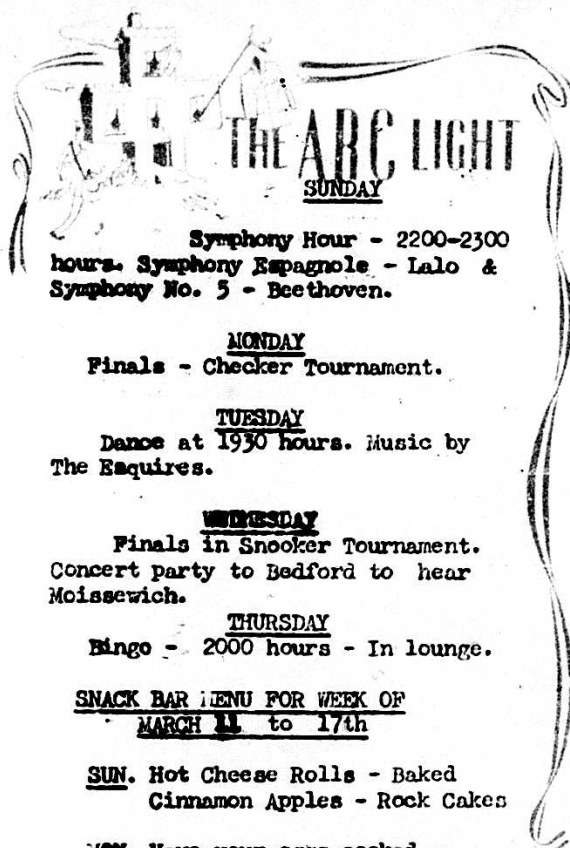
