Before a small but vociferous gathering the Thurleigh Gremlins elated out a 6 to 0 win over Harrington Saturday, 16 December at the Goldington Rd. Rugby grounds.

The score came in the 3rd period when Sellen, stellar back of the Thurleigh team, faded back to the mid-stripe and shot a beautiful long diagonal strike to Visconti who advanced it to the Harrington five.
