- 0146 Air raid warning purple
- 0210 Air raid warning white
- 0430 ops breakfast
- 0530 ~~attended briefing~~
- 0526 Div. tells us we are getting ^{one} Lib. coming here. - diversion. Call sign Globy G. from Harrington
three minute delay in T.O. - 4 ops.
- 0548 Globy G landed div. informed. Div. tells us two other Gs Globy J and K coming.
- 0559 Globy J landed div. informed
- 0610 Globy K landed div. informed
- 0620 Div. informs us Gc Pinnis O to be diverted to us.
- 0650 informed div. our Vis dropping

0650 Made necessary calls for ops. T.O. to be stationed at 0800

0700. Rcd to div. and ops.

0700 Picnic O has not shown up - called Harrington they were unable to contact him. Told them our field now closed.

0708 Div. informs us Picnic O. probably will not come here

0715 Ops informs us that T.O. has been delayed for 2 hrs. 556 D Lt. Peder in weather R/c to delay T.O. for two hrs
