0700 Red to Div. and ops.

0715 Cleared weather ship through 1130. 9.578 W/NQ20

MAJ. Kesting - Base, Honeybourne, Piddington
Bandbarof, Buckingham, Thame, Watford, Bradwell
Orfordness, back to Base.

0800 Weather ship airborne

0855 Weather ship landed, with high lights and
sodium lights - Vis 1000 yds.

0800 R/W changed to 24 N.E. to SW

11:25 Reported explosion to division & Lt. Little
Staughton. Found it to be a Home Guard
exercise.

12:00 A/c # 302 is cleared from Air Force to fly
to Bovingdon. Vis approx 1 mi at Bow.
Lt Klein on duty Lt. Carlile off.

14:15 Inspected airdrome. R/Ws & perimeter
serviceable. Asked 423 engr. to remove
debris on N-S R/W.

19:00 Crash crew, ambulance & A.F.C. dismissed
Inspected Obstruction lights, Everything
of danger marked. We are stand-by till
23:00

22:30 Stand down.
