0630

Lighting now off - sufficient daylight so that dome area can be seen from air. Watch maintained.

0850

Yellow Tr ops.

0930

A-I.R. and Clarence Log dispatched to 15<sup>1</sup> B.W.

- 1705 369 Sq. announces night flying.
- 2000 Briefed pilots on night flying.
- 2100 Ordered flare path laid NE-SW, # r'way # 24.
- 2115 Advised 1st Wing FC of night flying program.
- 2145 Requested Linnwood's Sandra light from desk T.F.N. Granted.  
Advised Linnwood of site flying program.
- 2147 Requested Wallisham FC to advise our A/c to return to base at 3,000 feet.
- 2200 Night flying begins.
