Briefed pilots that 2000yd vis. is expected at return. Flares on the approach will be same distances as usual. POSSIBLE USE of third flare at point where $9c$ turns on approach. Also informed them that point where base leg ~~to~~ should begin may be marked but NOT to expect it, as experimental work had not been carried out yet.
