

SAT. 21 - AUGUST, 1943

- 0001 Watch continued - All quiet.
- 0930 Yellow to ops.
- 0935 A. I. R. and clearance log of 20/8/43 dispatched.
- 0940 F/Lt. Bumpas of Wing 7/c requested further information regarding our Pundit. Kool was to give - mentioned in passing that Little Staughton had a pundit, perhaps they could spare. Checked with S/Lt. Staughton (F/Lt. Bumpas) and they so have one they could loan to us. Wing suggests we make necessary arrangements thru Motor Pool and Ordnance to obtain same.
- 1005 All arrangements made and completed for picking up Pundit belonging to S/Lt. Staughton. Will be here this P.M.
- 1100 Green to ops.
- 1200 Red to ops.
- 1230 On watch, Lt. Conrad. Off watch, Lt. Peterman.
- 1350 Aerodrome GREEN. Ops advised.
- 1455 Little Staughton's pundit delivered to us and found fully serviceable. 1 Wing FC informed, and Pundit #190 signalled to Station 2 as serviceable. (Number used on advise of Lt. Beebe, 1 Wing FC.)
- 2000 Ordered Blankets laid NE-SW.
