- 0001 All quiet.
- 0200 Last night-flying A/c lands. First Wing FC advised.
- 0700 Aerodrome YELLOW. Ops advised.
- 0845 Aerodrome RED. Ops advised. Practice mission scrubbed.
- 0855 Dispatched Aerodrome Inspection Report to signals for transmission to 1st Wing.
- 1048 Aerodrome YELLOW. Ops advised.
- 1140 Of two C61's signalled out of Hendon to us, having taken off at 0955, only one had arrived here. C.61-173, Maj. Stenlein, had not arrived. Called Flying Control Hendon. A/c in question had landed at Heston.
- 1155 Informed that bombing will take place on Lavender Range from 1700-2200 this day. Advised Ops, who notified proper authorities.
- 1220 T.O. W. W. W. T.
- 1340 R/W changed to NW/SE.
- 1530 R/W changed to NE/SW.
