The entire cost of the transportation, subsistence and quarters furnished under this order will be reported to the Commanding Officer, Liggett Military Reservation, Calif., as a proper charge against the pay of Private Frederick Malcom K., under the provisions of par. 20b, AR 30-920 and W. D. Circular 145, Par. 3, dated July 16, 1941.
