Par 3 AR 35-320, is aptd CIA Agent Fin O for the purpose of paying officers and EM of shipment E-7881-TD, for the period of shipment and will be reld by proper auth in the United States. Upon completion of this duty will proceed to Reception Center No 24 FT KNOX K.Y. for 90 days Recuperation leave.

Shipment E-7881-TD will move on 30 Dec 45 from present overseas station to Le Havre POE, CBS for shipment to the ZI. This movement is a temporary change of station for the purpose of reenlistment furlough or recuperation leave for all officers and EM listed in Section II STAT CODE YEY. For EM in Section III and IV STAT CODE YEB this is a permanent change of station for the purpose of reenlistment furloughs and further reassignment as indicated on personnel rosters attached.

LT COL ROBERT J. HILL O-21933 FA, is designated as group commander and custodian of records during actual movement of shipment E-7881-TD from time of departure until arrival in the United States. Each subordinate group commander (O or EM) will be custodian of records from the Port to the Reception Stations.

Shipment E-7881-TD will be under control of GG, ASF from time of departure from overseas station until relieved of assignment in the United States.

Each individual in this group will be issued clothing and equipment in accordance with change 5 ETO-SO No 61. ETO Jackets will be issued in addition.
